



10% Reload Bonus - Rules and Regulations

- Any current SaratogaBets account holder that has an established account will be eligible for a 10% reload bonus on deposits made on participating dates throughout 2013.
- The minimum deposit required to receive the reload bonus is \$50.
- The cumulative maximum total bonus a player can receive for this event is \$50 (on a total of \$500 deposited).
- The reload bonus will be deposited into their account by 5pm EST the next day, after the deposit clears.
- Account holders may use any available deposit method to receive the reload bonus.
- Account holders will be notified by email or regular mail when the reload bonus has been credited to their account.
- Account holders who receive the 10% reload bonus may not withdraw funds from their account until they have wagered at least 100% of their deposit + reload bonus. For Example: A player who reloads for \$200 will receive a \$20 Rewards Dollar Bonus. They must wager a minimum of \$220 before they can withdraw funds from their account.
- Account holders who have withdrawn funds during the promotion may only receive the reload bonus on the money they deposit above and beyond the amount they have withdrawn.
- IE: If a player has a withdrawal for \$300, they will only receive a reload bonus on any amount deposited above \$300. (This will guard against the player who withdrawals the \$300 only to redeposit the \$300 to receive the \$30 bonus.)
- Eligibility is limited to one person per SaratogaBets account wagering account.
- Bonus money is non-transferable and has no cash value.
- There are no implied benefits other than those published or posted.
- If at any time SaratogaBets' management becomes aware that a SaratogaBets' account holder is attempting to exploit or manipulate their account to receive the bonus, the matter shall be investigated by SaratogaBets. If as a result of such investigation it is determined that an account holder has in fact attempted to earn the 10% reload bonus via an impermissible method, such account holder will have his or her privileges revoked. The cash balance of any such forfeited account shall be refunded to the named account holder minus any sums attributable to reward dollars.
